<p>All students and staff will respect school property and environment.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *model picking up rubbish in the yard and putting it in the bin *Teach all classes about the different bins and what goes in each bin in class and outside *replace bins and have equipment repaired when necessary *Regularly reinforcing school values *Visual cues will be provide to help younger students - signs for bins *Bins will be emptied regularly *Make sure bins are in the yard during school time *Ensure class moves through corridors and the rest of the school respectfully *Consistently reinforce the rules, follow up, follow through 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Use the bins provided for rubbish, compost, recycling- inside class and outside *Pick up anything that is dropped or spilled *Use equipment appropriately and returning equipment to its correct location *Ask before taking others equipment *Stay out of the garden beds and Native garden as directed 	<p>Verbal responses – Well done for using the correct bin for your rubbish</p> <p>Assembly slide show highlighting appropriate behaviour – created by WASPS using the ipad.</p> <p>Non-verbal acknowledgement – thumbs up, smile</p> <p>Emu Award</p> <p>Environmental officers acknowledging appropriate use of equipment and caring for the environment</p>	<p>Remind students of appropriate behaviour</p> <p>Practice appropriate behaviour</p> <p>Redirect to another area or activity</p> <p>Walk with the teacher</p> <p>Time out of play – sit on a certain seat, walk with the teacher</p> <p>Community Service, Sweeping leaves/sandpit, picking up rubbish, watering/weeding the gardens</p> <p>Communicate with carers – phone call, note home , email</p>
