<p>All students and adults will be safe at school</p>	<p><u>Yard Duty Expectations</u> *Teachers will wear a High Visibility Vest on yard duty so they are visible in the yard. *Teachers are prompt to yard duty *Teachers are to be last leaving the yard duty area *Teachers to carry walkie-talkie's on duty *Follow up issues as they see them – don't leave for someone else</p> <p><u>Classroom Expectations</u> *Inform & reinforce Out of Bounds areas *Walk in shared areas * Inform & reinforce appropriate safety procedures – sport, cooking, science * Inform & reinforce a range of ways to manage feelings and issues *Inform students of the rules of the different play areas. * Inform & reinforce protective practices and Child Protection Curriculum</p> <p><u>Leadership</u> *Practise evacuations and in vacations *Expectations of play areas will be displayed on windows for all to see</p>	<p>*Walk bikes/ scooters in the school yard *Walk in shared spaces – corridors, wet areas, passage ways, around corners *Use equipment safely and in the appropriate areas of the yard *Use words to resolve issues and /or seek help from a teacher/adult *Return to class as the music is playing at the end of breaks and going to the toilet or getting a drink *Shoes to be worn at all times * Hats to be worn in Terms 1, 3 & 4 To show respect for the environment – e.g. climbing trees, breaking rocks, playing with sticks</p>	<p>Verbal feedback</p> <p>Non-verbal cues – smiles, thumbs up, nodding of head</p> <p>“Thank yous” for showing school values section of the school newsletter</p> <p>Have students take photos of safe play and show at assemblies</p>	<p>Reminder of appropriate behaviour</p> <p>Walk with the teacher</p> <p>Loss of next play time</p> <p>Restricted play area</p> <p>Individual play times</p> <p>Follow up talks with the Counsellor and inform class teacher</p> <p>Notes home</p> <p>Phone / personal conversations with parents/ caregivers</p>
