### Capital works update

In 2022, we will need to be agile around available spaces and the impact of our capital building project. While the end result will be fantastic, there are obviously challenges around managing a demolition/building site whilst maintaining school operations. As the build concept and costings are finalised, we are hopefully moving closer to being able to share detailed plans/images and a probable timeline for works.

We are currently awaiting confirmation of a date for flooring and acoustic boarding installation in the Gym to allow us to set it up as an alternative learning space for our Specialist Arts/Music and Resource Centre in 2022. Early week 9 is our preferred time for this work to be carried out, but it will be dependent upon supply logistics. In the meantime, we are proceeding with preparations to decant the resources in our Music Room, Resource Centre, OSHC and Rooms 3/4.

Removalists will be engaged to move all heavy/bulky items early Week 10 this term and OSHC will be relocated in time for the commencement of the holiday care program. We appreciate everyone's patience and support with this process and will continue to provide updates as more information is approved for release by our Department.
