Welcome to Warradale Primary School.

Warradale is a vibrant learning community with a proud history. Our strong community links and genuine connection with the local environment is central to developing confident and inquisitive, life-long learners.

We are very proud and supportive of our diverse and multicultural student population. Staff with high level skills and experience across the curriculum, work collaboratively with students and families to optimise learning outcomes. Targeted programs in Literacy, Numeracy, Aboriginal Education and English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EALD) aim to meet the needs of learners at all academic and developmental levels.

Plans have been approved for a major redevelopment of our school, which will include five new classroom learning areas, a serviced learning area, resource centre and modern administration block. We are hopeful that work will start on site in 2022 and be completed in 2023.

We are sharpening our focus on high quality teaching and learning across the primary years. Increasing achievement in English/Reading and Mathematics a priority, and consistent, whole-school approaches to curriculum delivery and high impact teaching pedagogies is driving this work.

Specialist educators deliver R-7 teaching and learning programs in Health and Physical Education, Japanese (Language Other Than English) and The Arts.

A range of extra-curricular offerings ensure the wide and varied needs of our students are well catered for. Access to wetland, native vegetation and vegetable garden areas on-site enable students to connect their learning to valuable local contexts and experiences.

We are connected to SWIFT (Schools with Internet Fibre Technology) and have a range of electronic devices and platforms to support students to connect locally and globally. Students and educators in Years 3 to 6 have excellent access to Chromebook devices and we are building our whole school ICT capability. The Seesaw communication application provides students, teachers and leadership with the facility to connect with parents and share evidence of learning in real time.

We offer our full commitment to supporting your child's primary school education here at Warradale and look forward to working with you to set them up for success.
